THE TERMS OF REFERENCE

PREAMBLE:

The 'Training Institution' as approved by the IPPCC Reforms & Intergovernmental Committee and engaged by the Registry of Political Parties to provide training to members of parliament, officials of political parties and staff of the Registry shall:

1. Research and identify training needs of the members of parliament, officials of political parties and staff of the registry;
2. Put together a tailored training package for this program;
3. Identify the scope and limitations of the Short and Long term Training programs for the Registry of Political parties;
4. Outsource highly qualified, experienced and mature resource personnel to conduct training for and on behalf of the Registry;

5. Provide actual training to the members of parliament, officials of political parties & staff of the Registry of Political Parties;
6. Outsource other avenues of funding to further enhance and facilitate training;
7. Training Programs designed remain the intellectual property of the Training Institution engaged and the Registry of Political Parties;
8. Operate within this Terms of Reference;
9. Operate within the conditions of the Memorandum of Agreement; and finally,
10. Discuss with the Registrar other avenues of Training as the need arises over time.
